Sammendrag av studentene sin evaluering / Summarize the results from the student evaluation

The student evaluation report indicates that, on average, students spent 6.6 hours per week on the course and found the lectures and seminars to be very interesting and relevant. The instructors and seminar tutors were rated highly for their competence and care. The syllabus was also considered relevant and up-to-date. The students also reported that the workload was perceived as manageable, and that they felt satisfied with their efforts and the teaching methods. Overall, students' felt that they had learned a lot from the course and would recommend it to others. One student suggested having weekly seminars to better manage the large curriculum and address questions related to the weekly chapters.

Emneansvarligs evaluering / The course coordinator's evaluation

Overall, the course went well with engaged students who participated actively in class. There was effective collaboration between me and the seminar leaders, who did an excellent job. This year, I also connected each lecture to the theme of the essay, which I believe worked well and was well received by the students and the seminar leaders. However, the main issue was the assessment process. With 65 students submitting 2000-word essays and 61 students taking an exam with four 300-word responses each, grading and providing feedback was an overwhelming task for one person. For future iterations, I recommend having multiple graders for essays and exams, and possibly modifying the exam format to include auto-corrected questions on Inspira to reduce the grading workload.
