1. Teacher's assessment of the implementation 1.1 Practical implementation
The course consisted of two consecutive 45 minute lectures each week taught by myself, and a two-hour practical class each week. The practical class included three compulsory assignments which the students had to pass in order to gain admittance to the exam. The exam was worth 100% of the final mark. The course was very intensive, and the combination of lectures and practical work was necessary to ensure learning.

1.2 Failure rate and dropout
No one failed the final exam.

1.3 Grade distribution
The most common grade was B, with several A's and several C's.
